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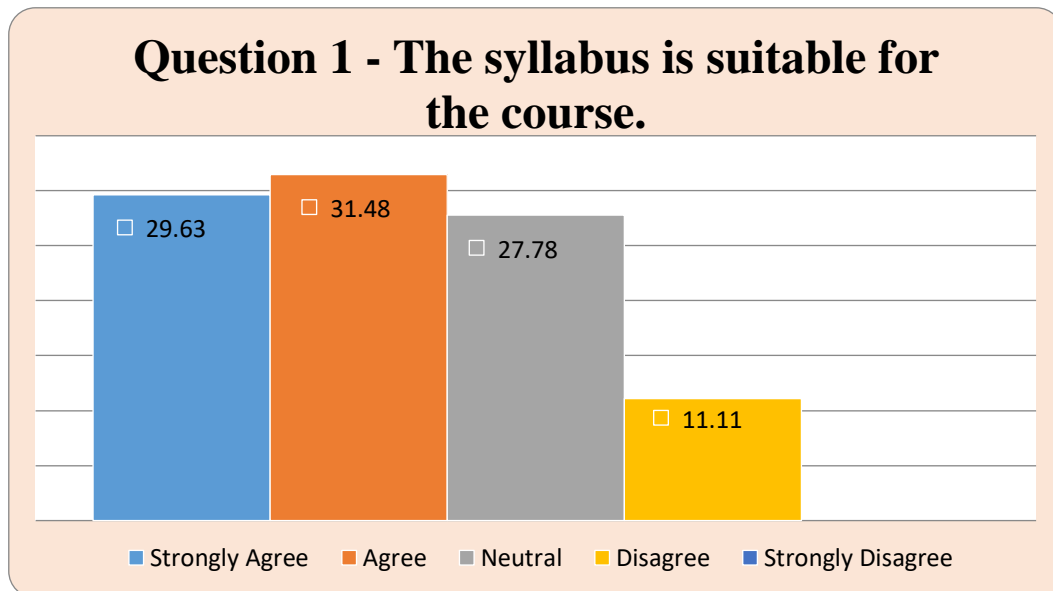
## TEACHERS FEEDBACK – DATA ANALYSIS & INTERPRETATION

### Question 1 - Syllabus is suitable for the course.

Table 1 reveals that 29.63% of teachers strongly agree that the course syllabus is suitable for the course. 31.48% of teachers agree for the same. 27.78% of teachers' views are neutral. 11.11% of teachers disagree that the course syllabus is suitable for the course.

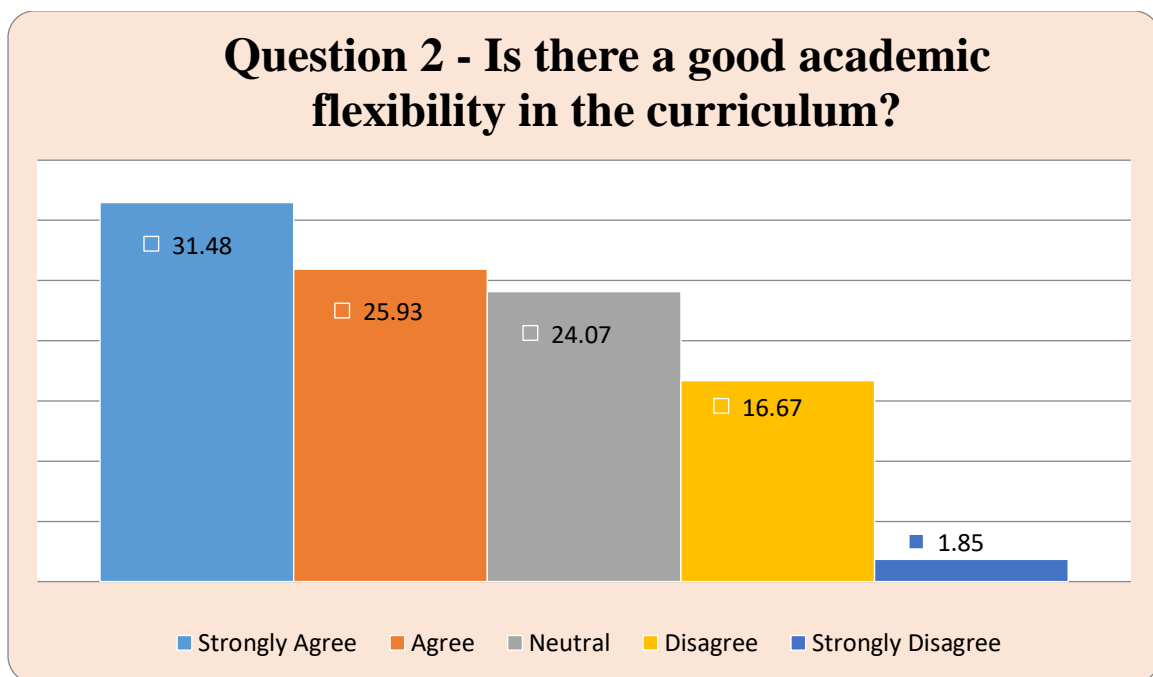
  
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### Question 2 - Is there a good academic flexibility in the curriculum?

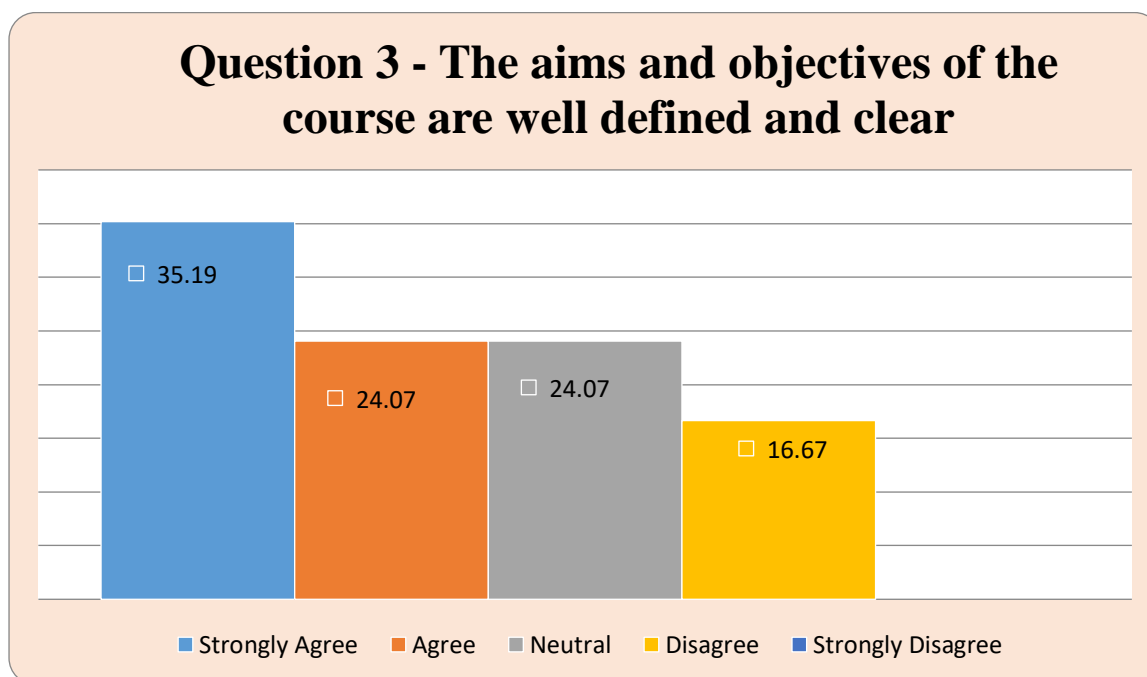
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**Question 3 - Aims and objectives of the syllabi are well defined and clear to teachers and students.**

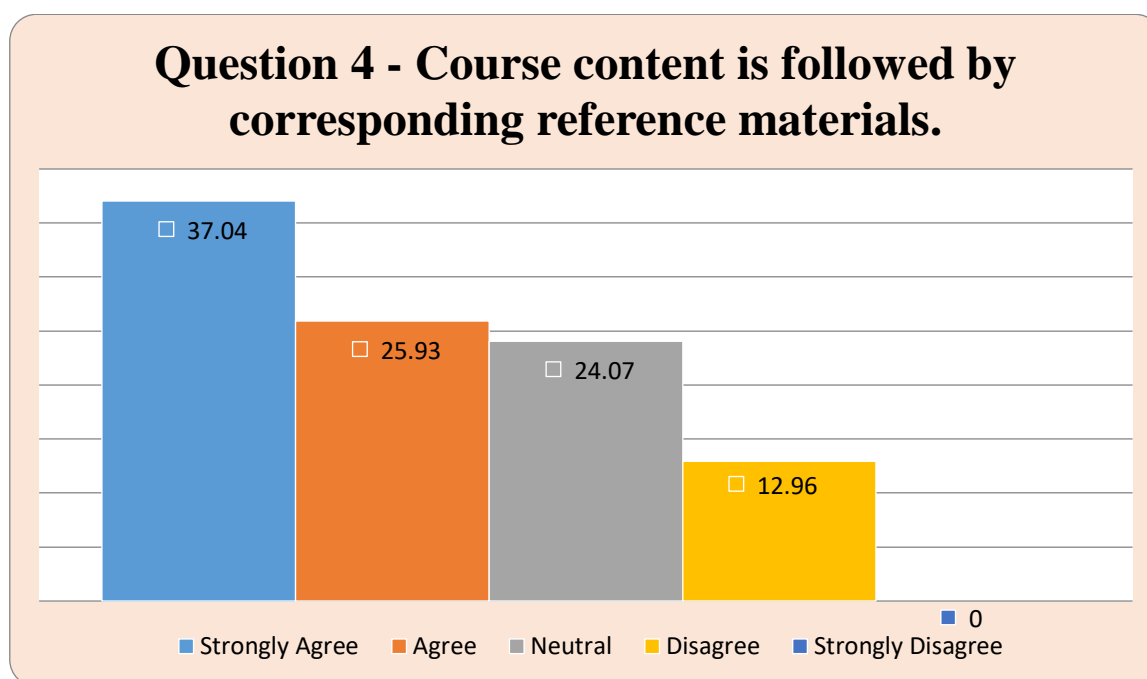
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**Question 4 - Course content is followed by corresponding reference materials.**

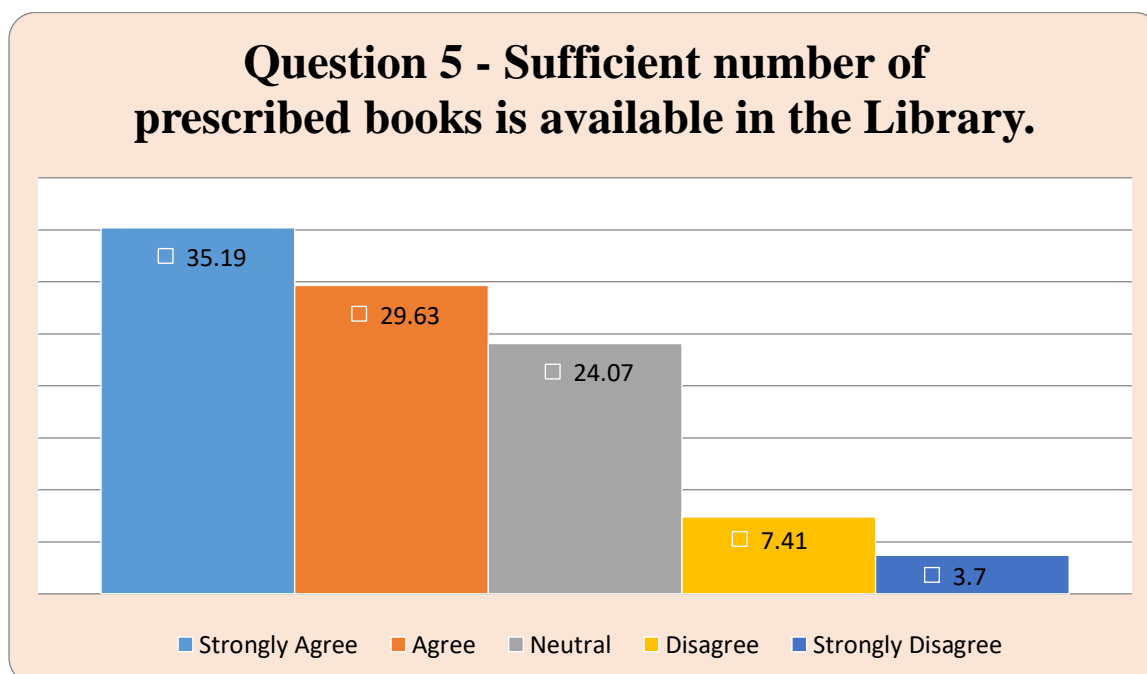
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**Question 5 - Sufficient number of prescribed books is available in the Library.**

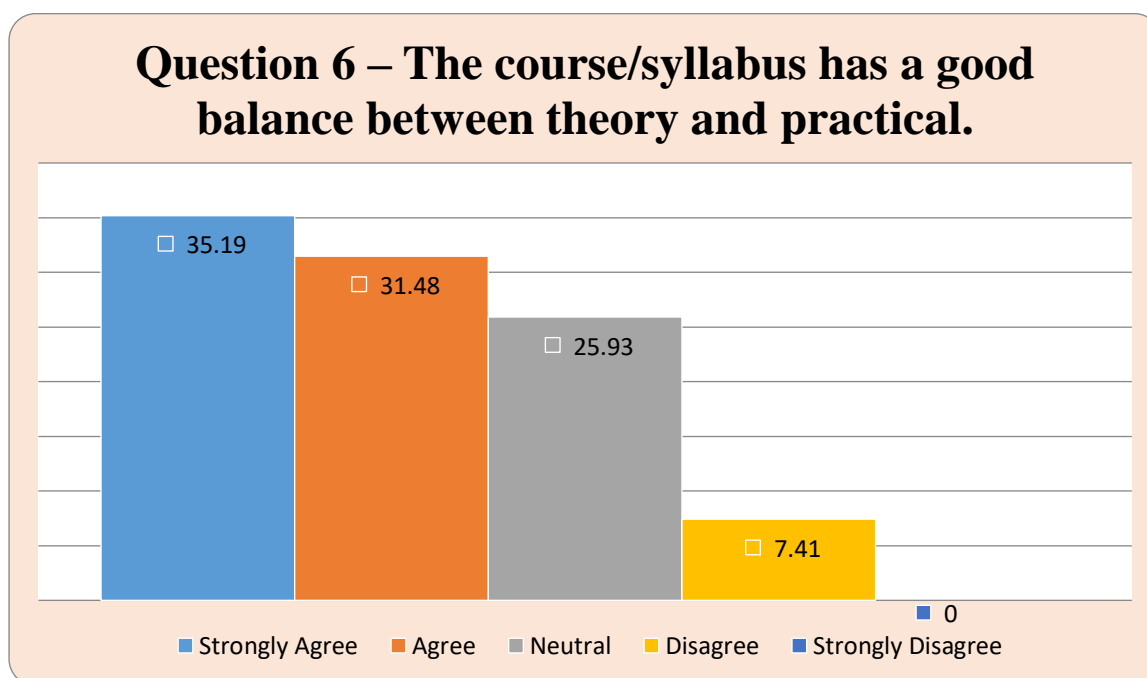
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**Question 6 – The course/syllabus has a good balance between theory and practical.**

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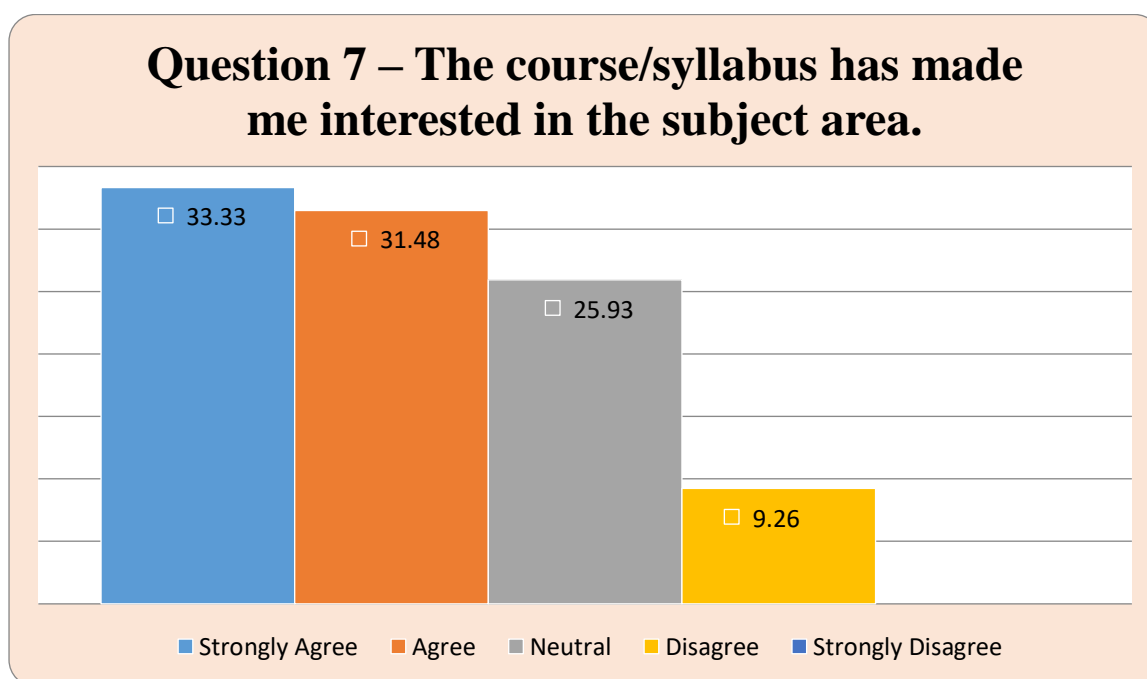


**Question 7 – The course/syllabus has made me interested in the subject area.**

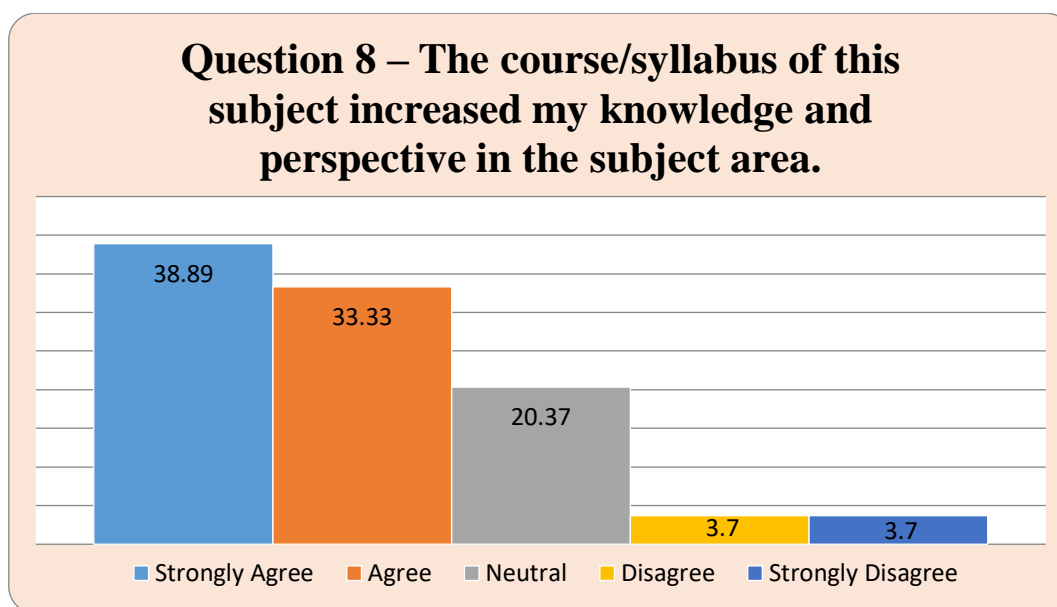
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**Question 8 – The course/syllabus of this subject increased my knowledge and perspective in the subject area.**
