SSTians study visit to MAHINDRA AUTOMOBILE INDUSTRY



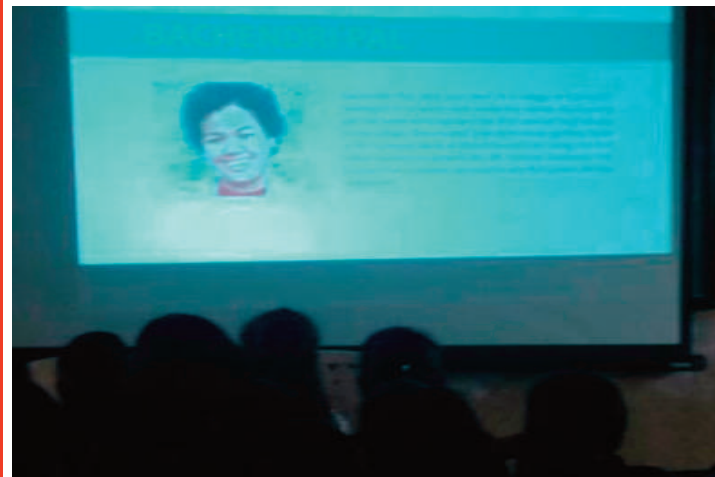
