SST College Examination Committee organized National Level Webinar on “EXAM STRESS RELIEF”




During the lockdown period, SST College organized National and International level webinars on various academic topics under the theme 'Vidyadan'.


When ashish's father passed away only when he was six months old, his mother was working as a teacher. His mother always encouraged him to dream big. His mother says that it was Ashish's dream to work as

About this choice of Ashish, the Founding Principal of SST College, Dr. J. C. Puraswani congratulated him and also felicitated him on behalf of the SST college.


SST College cultural committee Virtual Ganshostava (Eka – Akshara)


Dr. J. C. Purswani, Founder Principal of SST College expressed his views and expressed his intentions of organising such webinars in future.


SSTian Sandip Joyeshi won Silver Medal in the State Level Junior Athletics Championship
