To help the students to understand the structure for preparation of the Foundation Course project.

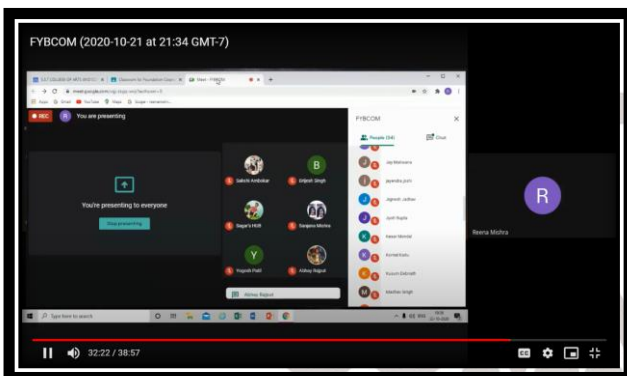
Outcome:

Students understood the technique to prepare the Foundation Course project.

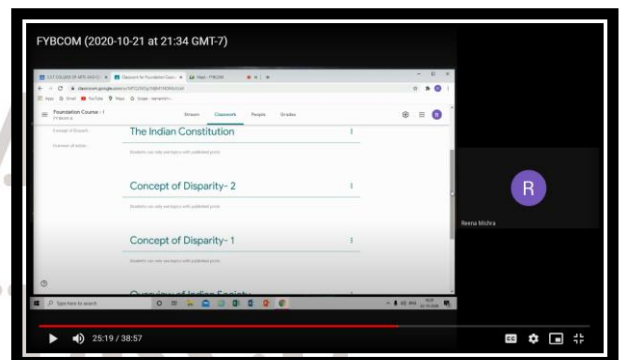
Report:

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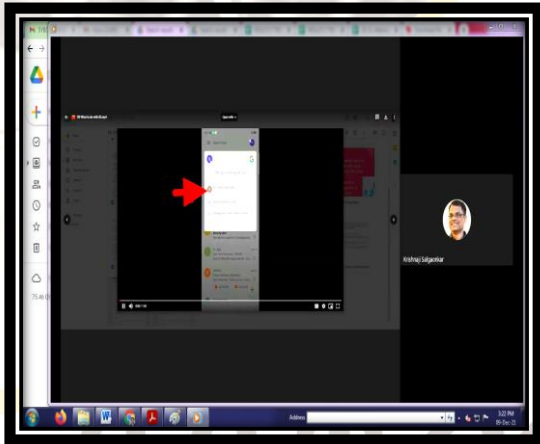
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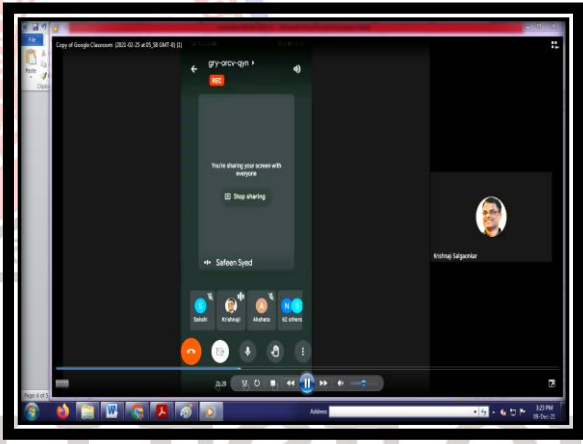
