On 27th February, 2020 students of BMM/BAMMC along with the faculty members took the initiative to organise 'Rajyastariy Kavi Sammelan' (State Level Poetry convention)

Nowadays, as English-mixed Marathi language is spoken, the Barakhadi (alphabets in Marathi) is also being forgotten, so they had made a Barakhadi tree near the entrance. The names of writers from Sant Dnyaneshwar to P.L.Deshpande were written on the balloons in the hall where the poetry convention was held.

The founder Principal of the College, Dr. Purswani Sir and Chief Guest Sagar Nimbalkar, a well-known poet lit the lamp. After that, despite the principal being a non-Marathi speaker himself, he gave an excellent speech in fluent and pure Marathi language. In his speech, he also reminded that one should do something as a symbol of love for one's mother tongue and save it.

After that the poetry convention started. The meeting was divided into open groups and college groups. Many participated enthusiastically.

In the open group, poets from Chembur, Vikhroli to Titwala and Boisar participated. Most importantly, a 75-year-old grandfather named Ravindra Sonawane from Titwala was present and set a new standard of inspiration by inspiring the youth by presenting

poetry. More than 22 students from Joshi Bedekar College to Bharat College participated in the college group.

In this poetry convention, many excellent poems were presented on various subjects from the farmers suicides in Vidarbha to the condition of Mumbai and from love to even separation. Apart from this, faculty Manisha Agale also presented a poem composed by her when she was 12 years old.






WEBINAR: CONCEPTUAL BACKGROUND DESIGN FOR MOVIE ANIMATION AND GAMES!
