FY Induction

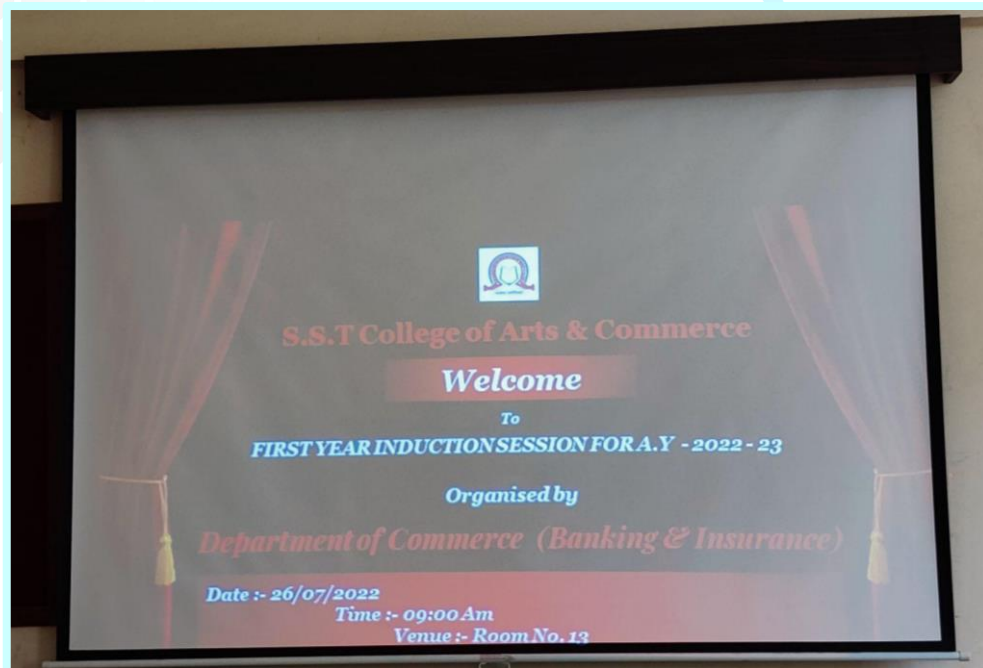

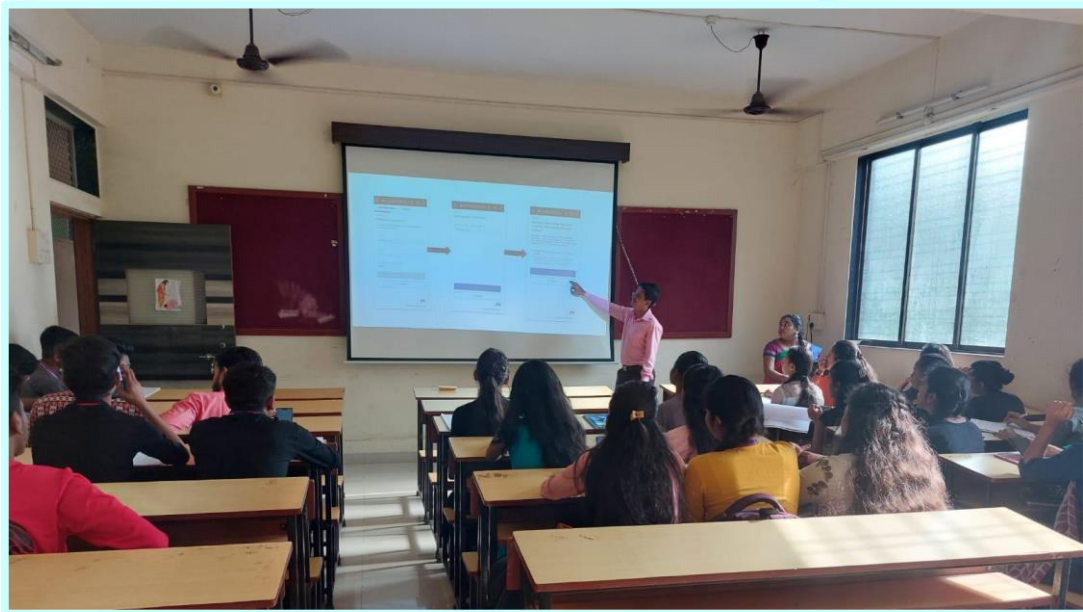

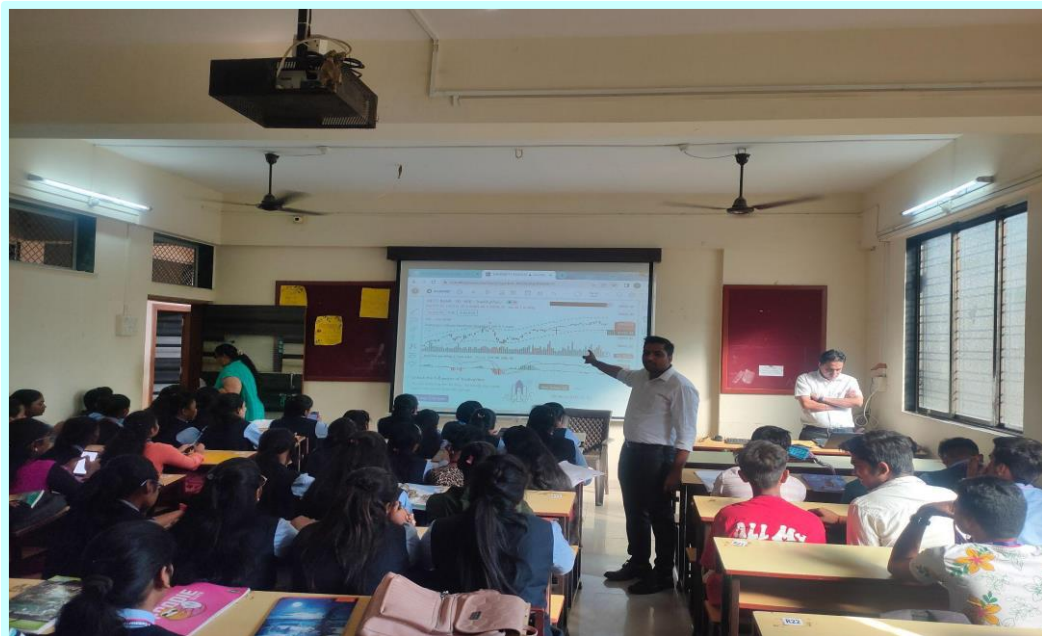

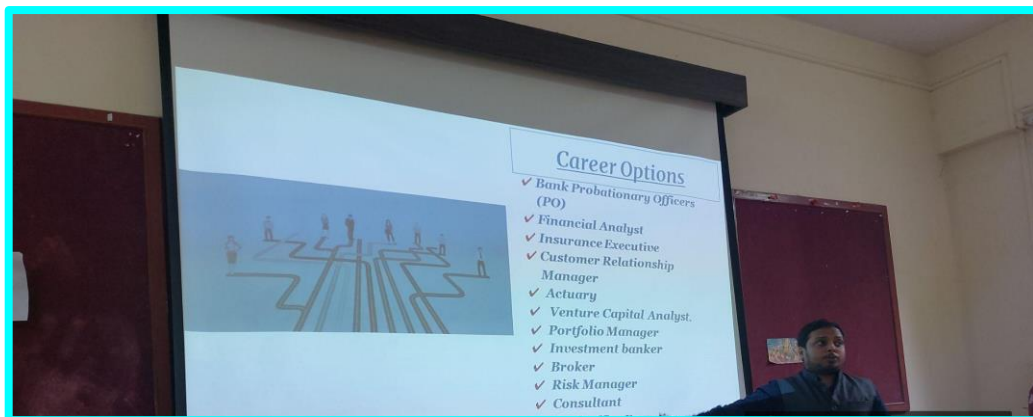
