

SESSION ON ONLINE INDUCTION


SUMMARY REPORT

SAFE RIDING TRAINING SESSION


SUMMARY REPORT


The Resource Person briefed students how to calculate safe distance by the formula and find the blind.

Digital Banner on Safe Rider Training Session








WEBINAR ON FINANCIAL LITERACY



WEBINAR ON CONSUMER RIGHTS & INVESTORS AWARENESS


SUMMARY REPORT
