He mentioned the targets of Goal to be achieved by 2030 include: stepped up efforts to reduce greenhouse gas emissions; improved education, awareness, human and institutional capacity for mitigation, adaptation, impact reduction, and early warning; strengthen resilience and adaptive capability.
