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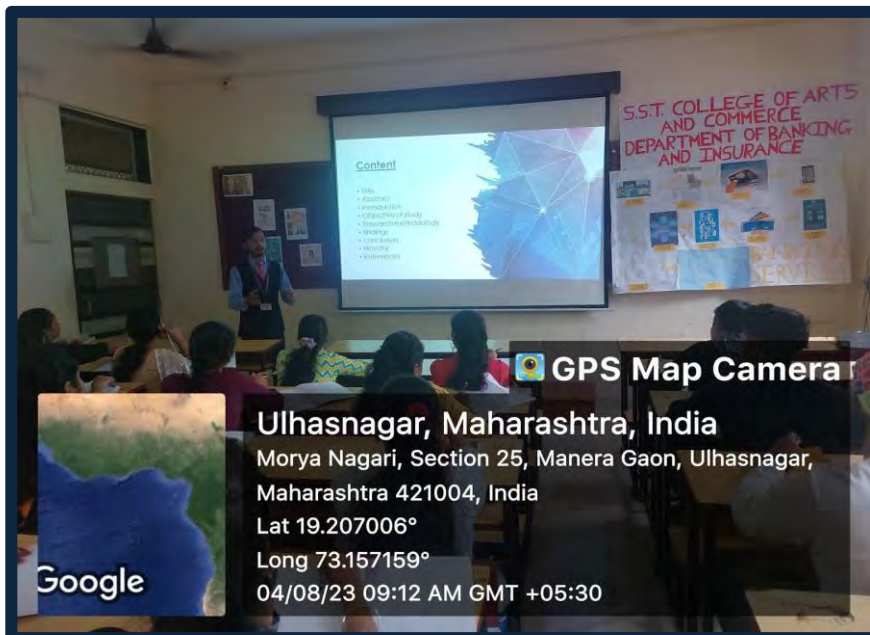


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Research Activity - Introduction to Research

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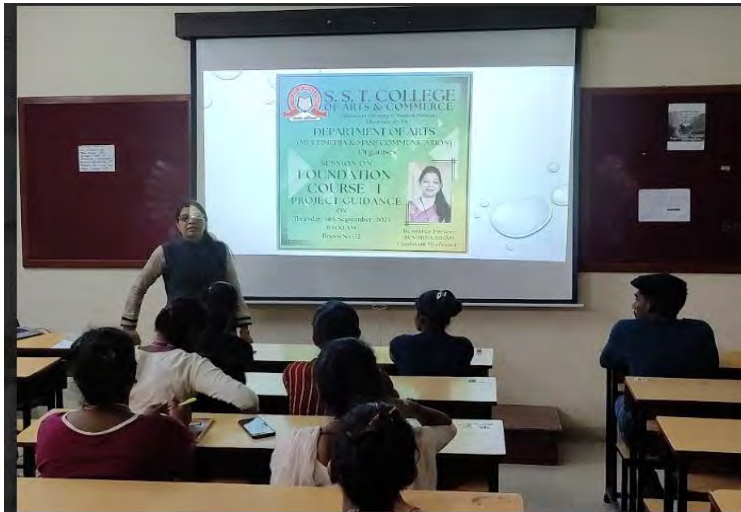

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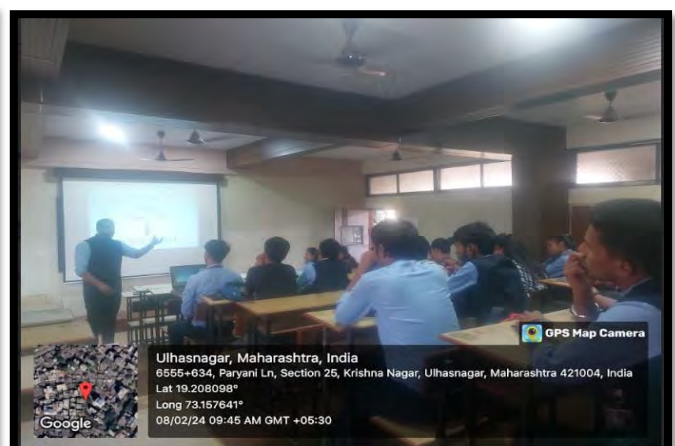


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Research Activity - Research Guidance for Project work

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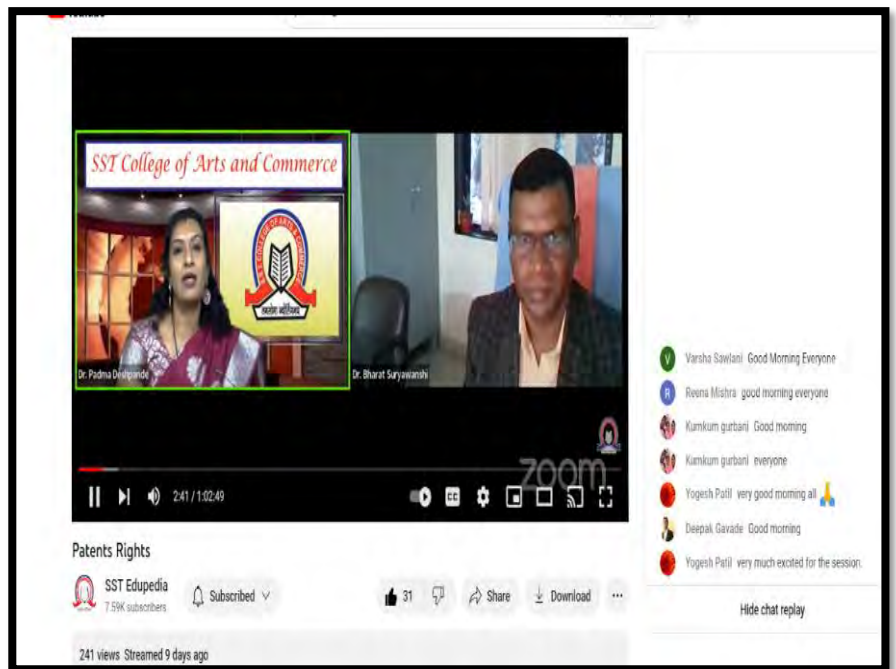

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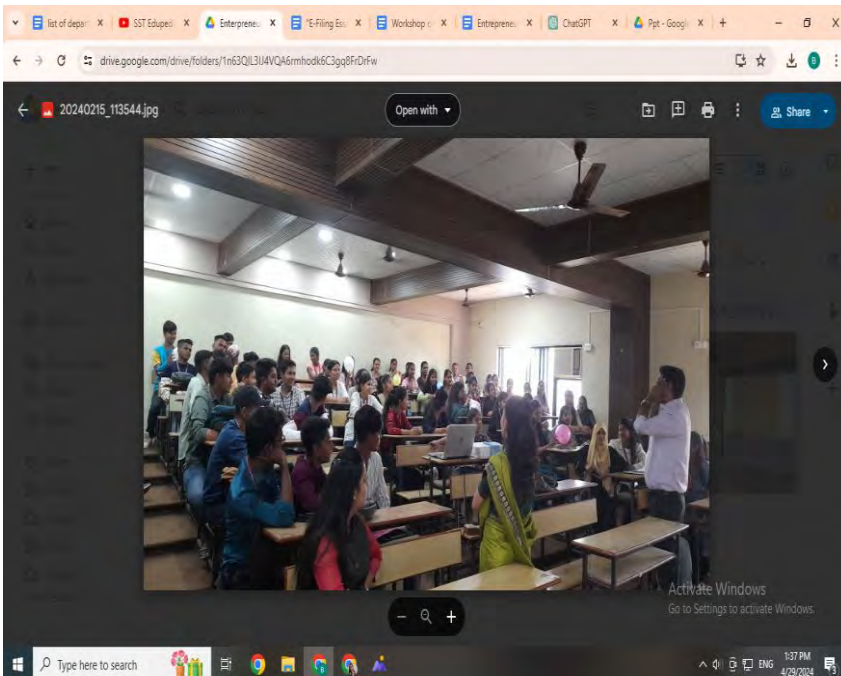

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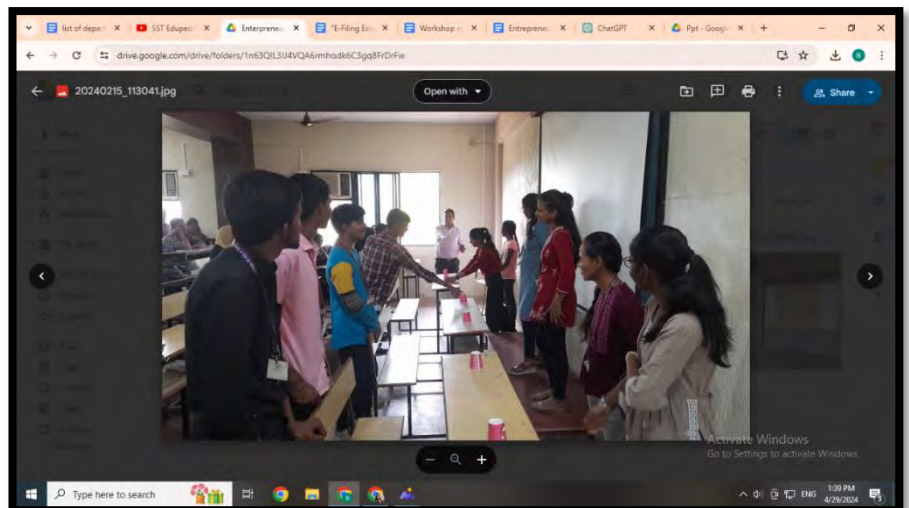
