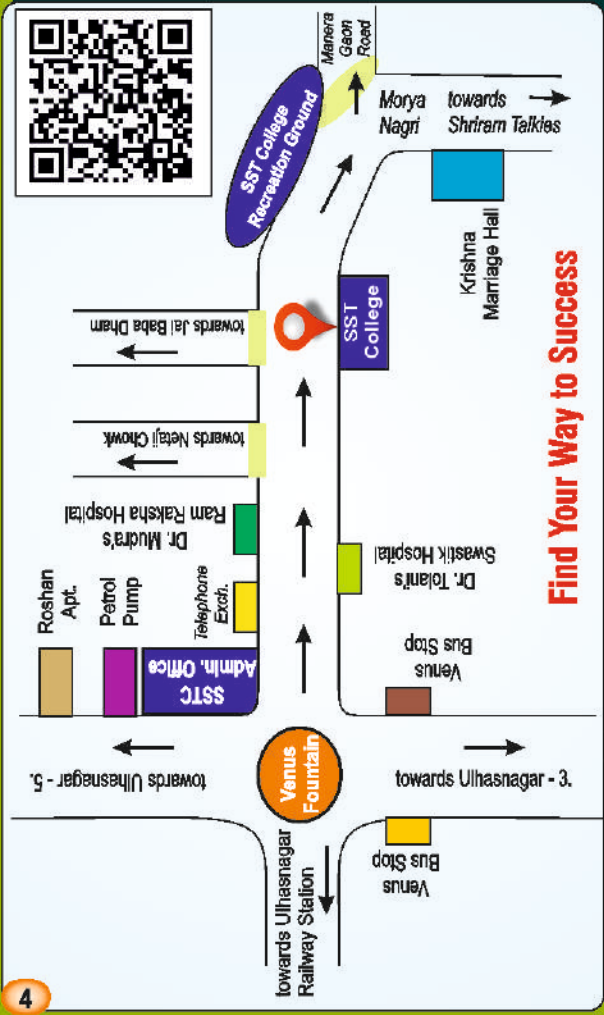

NEP 2020 emphasizes a holistic, flexible, and multidisciplinary approach to education that nurtures creativity, critical thinking, and problem-solving abilities, while reducing exam pressure and rote learning.

The policy encourages a dynamic learning environment, aiming to equip students with the skills needed to face national and global challenges. It also promotes lifelong learning through a well-rounded curriculum.

University of Mumbai: NEP 2020 Implementation

Starting from the academic year 2024–25, the University of Mumbai has adopted NEP 2020 across its non-autonomous colleges. New three- and four-year undergraduate degree programs have been launched, offering greater flexibility, skill development, and multidisciplinary learning.

The university has rolled out revised curriculum for more than 100 subjects across BA, BSc, and BCom programs, aligning with the NEP framework to prepare students for diverse career pathways.

BASIC FRAMEWORK OF NEP CHOICE BASED CREDIT SYSTEM

Students can tailor their academic journey with a choice-based credit system that supports flexibility and personal interests. The syllabus includes various verticals as below

Major : A Single Major/Compulsory Course for the Programme Pursued by the Student.

Minor : 2nd Course pursued by the student as additional requirement of the programme.

Open Elective- Elective Course related to unrelated to the particular course (Multidisciplinary approach)

Vocational Skill Course – A Course Aimed at imparting Practical Skill/Hands on training/ soft skills to increase employability of students.- Can be Specific or supporting the major course.

Skill Enhancement Course – To increase employability – chosen from Basket of MOOC/Swayam/NPTEL platforms.

IKS – Indian Knowledge System Course.- Culture, Indian Traditional System of Medicine,Astronomy, Yoga,Arthashastra etc.

	On the Job Training/Internship/ Field Projects/Research Project etc.
	Co Curricular Activities – Cultural activities like performing arts, visual art, NCC,NSS, Yoga etc.
	Community Engagement Service (CEP)- Activities to expose students to socio economic issues in society, Theoretical learning supplemented by Real life experiences.

FOR JUNIOR COLLEGE :

Students passing the S.S.C. (X) Examination of Maharashtra State Board of Secondary Education or equivalent examination from other boards are eligible for admission to the first year Jr. College (F.Y.J.C.)



FOR DEGREE COLLEGE :

1) A student passing H.S.C. (XII) standard in a given stream can apply for admission to the First Year B.A., B.Com and other classes as applicable.

A) Students coming from Universities / Board other than Maharashtra State :

Students coming from outside i.e. other than Maharashtra State Board, will be admitted provisionally to the College. In case admission of the student found to be invalid for any reason, the responsibility will lie with the student. Students will account for the gap if any, between passing the H.S.C. examination and joining F.Y. Class by submitting gap certificate. Students from other state are required to have ENGLISH as a compulsory subject at H.S.C. examination.

B) International Students : Foreign students seeking admission are required to submit following documents along with other documents.

- a) Photo copy of passport
- b) Copy of Transcript

2) A student passing XII Science / Commerce can seek admission to F.Y.B.A. Course.

3) Students migrating to this college from another college affiliated to University of Mumbai will have to produce a Digital Transference Certificate along with Permanent Registration Number from the college last attended. If migrating from a College affiliated to another University, students will have to produce Transference Certificate and Migration Certificate from the previous University.

4) All applications must be duly filled and accompanied by the necessary fees and documents.

5) Admission will be treated as provisional until the final Enrolment/ Eligibility is confirmed by University of Mumbai.

0.2859 : Refund of Tuition, Development & all other fees after cancellation of admissions:

REFUND OF FEES POLICY

As per the University of Mumbai Circular No. UG/412 of 2008 dated 11th September 2008, candidates who have taken admission in undergraduate courses in Government colleges, Government-aided and unaided courses conducted by affiliated colleges and recognized institutions are eligible to apply for a refund of fees upon cancellation of admission.

Students must submit a written application for cancellation of admission. The applicable refund amount will be processed on or before the 30th day from the date of cancellation. The percentage of the course fee refunded will be determined after deducting the charges as outlined in Table 1 (to be inserted below), based on the period of cancellation.

Note:

The total amount considered for the refund includes all fee components chargeable for one academic year, as per the University's relevant circulars for different faculties (excluding courses where fees are fixed by other competent authorities).

◆ Non-refundable components include:

- ◆ Fees paid towards Group Insurance.
- ◆ University shares such as Vice-Chancellor Fund, Sports and Cultural Activity Fees, E-charges, Disaster Management Fund, Examination Fees, and Enrolment Fees if already remitted by the college before the cancellation.
- ◆ Charges for Identity Card, Library Card, Admission Form, Prospectus, and any course-specific fee after the commencement of the academic term.
- ◆ All refundable deposits (Laboratory, Caution Money, Library, etc.) shall be refunded at the time of cancellation.
- ◆ Where admissions are conducted through centralized admission processes (e.g., for professional courses), refund rules specified by such competent authorities shall apply for first-year admissions.
- ◆ For admissions to subsequent years of the course, the Ordinance 0.2859 shall be applicable.
- ◆ The refund rules are in concurrence with regulations prescribed by any other statutory bodies governing the concerned courses.



IMPORTANT :

Ordinances 0.2859-A and 0.2859-B have been replaced. The revised Ordinance 0.2859, governing the refund of Tuition Fees, Development Fees, and all other fees upon cancellation of admission to undergraduate courses, has been in effect from the academic year 2008-2009.

REFUND OF DEPOSITS:



Application for the refund of deposit must be made between 1st September to 30th September or 1st February to 28th February of the year when applicant ceases to be a student of the college, failing which the deposit will be forfeited.

CODE OF CONDUCT

ADMISSION & DOCUMENTATION

- ▶▶ The Principal reserves the right to refuse admission without stating reasons.
- ▶▶ Students seeking admission must complete the prescribed form with required documents.
- ▶▶ All admissions remain provisional until confirmed by the University.
- ▶▶ If the original H.S.C. mark sheet is submitted elsewhere, a certificate from that institution's Principal must be furnished.
- ▶▶ Admission is valid for one academic year and must be renewed annually.
- ▶▶ Personal presence of the student is mandatory during admission.
- ▶▶ Retain all receipts; refunds of deposits require original receipts.
- ▶▶ The original School Leaving Certificate (X/XII) must be submitted and will not be returned.



IDENTITY & ATTENDANCE

- ▶▶ Identity Cards are mandatory for campus entry and must be worn around the neck. Non-compliance is considered indiscipline.
- ▶▶ Admission is not granted without submission of required documents and payment of fees.
- ▶▶ F.Y. admissions are merit-based as per University and Government norms.
- ▶▶ Attendance in lectures, practicals, seminars, and exams is compulsory. Medical leave must be supported by valid certification.
- ▶▶ Latecomers may be denied entry into classrooms.
- ▶▶ No student may undertake employment, business, or coaching during college hours.



CAMPUS CONDUCT

- ▶▶ Students must not bring unauthorized individuals to campus.
- ▶▶ No fundraising is allowed without the Principal's permission.
- ▶▶ Unapproved meetings, demonstrations, picnics, or parties are prohibited.
- ▶▶ College-related information must not be shared externally without approval.
- ▶▶ Misconduct or serious indiscipline may lead to expulsion.

RULES OF LIBRARY

The College Library is the intellectual heart of our institution, offering students a peaceful environment, curated collections, and access to diverse academic resources. Students are encouraged to make the most of this facility by adhering to the following rules and guidelines."

● Library Access

Students must carry their Library Card at all times while entering the Library and must present it when requested by Library staff.

● Silence is Essential

Maintaining complete silence is mandatory. Any student disturbing the reading environment (e.g., talking, discussions) may be restricted from using Library facilities.

● Home Reading Membership

Students wishing to borrow books for home reading must fill out a membership form and pay a refundable deposit of ₹250 (Subject to reservation). A Reader's Ticket will be issued, which allows borrowing of two books for 7 days, as per the stream-wise schedule.

● Reading Room Facility

Books, including textbooks and reference materials, can be read in the Library using the Library Card. Taking books outside without permission will result in a ₹50 fine and may lead to suspension of borrowing privileges.

● Overnight Issuance

Books may be issued for overnight use after 3:00 p.m. and must be returned by 9:30 a.m. the next day. Late returns will attract a fine of ₹2 per book.

● Newspapers & Periodicals

Newspapers and periodicals may be read within the Library using a valid college I-Card. Bound volumes of journals are for current reading only and cannot be taken outside.

● Check for Missing Pages

Students must check books for any missing or damaged pages before borrowing and report issues immediately. Responsibility for damage or missing pages upon return will lie with the last borrower.

● Book Care & Handling

Students must handle Library materials with care. Writing, marking, tearing, or damaging books is strictly prohibited. The last borrower will be held accountable and must replace the damaged book along with a ₹10 processing fee.

● Late Return Fines

A fine of ₹2 per day will be charged for books returned after the due date.

● Lost Book Policy

In case of loss, the student must replace the book. If unavailable, double the original price plus ₹10 as processing fees must be paid.

● Non-Transferable Cards

Reader's Tickets are strictly non-transferable. Lending them to others will result in suspension of Library privileges.

● Clearance Requirement

The College Leaving Certificate/Transfer Certificate will be issued only after the student clears all Library dues and returns all borrowed materials.

● Renewal Deadlines

Students of XII, S.Y., and T.Y. must renew their Reader's Ticket by 31st July of each academic year. Delays will incur a fine of ₹50 per month.

● Issuance for New Students

Students of XI, F.Y., and postgraduate programs must collect their Reader's Tickets within the notified schedule. Delayed issuance will be permitted only in special cases with prior permission from the Principal.

● Duplicate Cards

In case of loss, students can apply for a duplicate Reader's Ticket at the Library Counter by filling out the prescribed form and paying ₹50.

● Mobile Phone Ban

Use of mobile phones is strictly prohibited inside the Library. Violations will lead to confiscation of the phone for one week, or a fine of ₹500, or both.

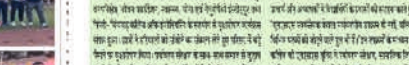
